Mission

Unity

- Second, we are a community of people who have made a commitment to the building of strong family identity. We believe that parents/guardians are responsible for the spiritual and moral training of their children, and we are actively involved in the pursuit and practice of biblical principles of parenting in our homes.
- Third, we are a community of people who agree that God has ordained parents/guardians as the educators of their children. parent/guardian who choose to delegate this task to a school, do so as an act of partnership, and the school comes alongside the parent/guardian, working in unison with them to fulfill God's command (Deuteronomy 6: 6-7).

Statement of Faith

Members of our Administration, faculty, and staff teach and proclaim only those doctrines in agreement with our Statement of Faith. We desire to glorify God by being zealous about the things that truly build up the body of Christ and clearly communicate the gospel of Christ - speaking the truth in love.

Bible

We believe the Bible to be the authoritative Word of God, inerrant, verbally inspired, and infallible in its original state (II Timothy 3:15, II Peter 1:21).

God

We believe that there is but one living and true God, perfect in all his attributes, one in essence, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1, Matthew 28:19, John 10:30).

Man

We believe that God created all things as described in Genesis. We believe that the first man, Adam, sinned, bringing spiritual death to all mankind, who therefore, stands condemned, making the new birth absolutely necessary (John 3:3).

Salvation

We believe that salvation is wholly of God by grace on the basis of the redemption of Jesus Christ, the merit of His shed blood and not on the basis of human merit or works. God gives eternal life to those who repent of their sins, and put their faith in Christ alone, justifying them instantaneously by the blood of Christ and imputing His righteousness to them (Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 John 1:9).

Marriage

We believe because God has ordained marriage and defined it as the covenant relationship between a man, a woman, and Himself, CPA will only recognize marriages between a man and a woman. We believe that God wonderfully and unchangeably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God. We believe that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture. We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other. We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of marriage between a man and a woman. We believe that any form of sexual immorality is sinful and offensive to God (Genesis 1:26-27; Genesis 2:18-25; 1 Cor. 6:18, 1 Cor 7:2-5, Hebrews 13:4; Matt. 15: 18-20, 1 Cor. 6: 9-10)

Human Life

We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of priceless worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value all human life (Psalm 139: 13-18, Job 14:5).

The Church

We believe in the importance of the local church, which is made up of believers, who gather for worship, fellowship, and teaching. We believe in the responsibility of the church to fulfill the great commission of Christ, preaching the gospel of Christ to all nations (Hebrews 10:25; Matthew 28:19-20).

The Future

We believe in the eternal existence of the soul, resurrection of the body, eternal blessedness of believers and eternal punishment of unbelievers. We believe that eternal life is a free gift of grace bestowed upon each repentant sinner who responds in faith to the provision of salvation from Jesus Christ (John 5:24-25; 1 Corinthians 6:14).
